HOW IT WORKS

1. When you call or submit an online tip, be sure to give every detail you know or remember.
2. The information you submit is collected in Texas and it is hidden.
3. You will be given a tip number. Keep that number and don't share it with anyone.
4. PSC sends the information to the school and the police department.
5. The school and police department will decide whether your tip was useful or not.
6. You will be told how to check if your tip was useful and how to collect your reward anonymously.

Project Safe Campus is a program provided to students that offers an anonymous way to report crime. That means you can report problems or crimes without being identified by name.

WHY REPORT?

- If you notice unusual or strange behavior or something that makes you uncomfortable, it can be a sign of a problem.
- If you are the victim or witness of a problem at school or in your neighborhood, you may feel alone or scared.
- It's a good idea to talk to a parent, guardian, or school counselor about a problem in and around your school.
- If you feel like you need more help, you can submit a tip to Project Safe Campus.



BE AWARE

of your surroundings on your campus and in your neighborhood.

BE EMPOWERED

to be strong and confident. You have the right to a safe and secure environment in and around your school.

BE ENCOURAGED

to report behavior that might bring harm to ANYONE. For example:

- An animal
- Your school

Here are some examples of problems you should report:

IN-SCHOOL TIPS

If actionable you will receive
a \$100 VISA CARD

- Alcohol & Drugs
- Bullying
- Computer Crime
- Fighting
- Potential Suicides
- Skipping School
- Stealing
- Weapons

OUT-OF-SCHOOL TIPS

If arrest is made you will receive
up to a \$2500 CASH REWARD

- Animal Abuse
- Child Abuse
- Drunk Driving
- Family Violence
- Gang Activity
- Kidnapping
- Setting Fires
- Sexual Assault
- Shootings
- Stealing Cars
- Suspicious Activity
- Underage Drinking
