HOW IT WORKS

1. When you call or submit an online tip, be sure to give every detail you know or remember.
2. The information is collected in Texas, and it is encrypted.
3. You will be given a tip number. Keep that number and don't share it with anyone.
4. PSC sends the information to the school and the police department.
5. The principal and police department will validate whether your tip was actionable or not.
6. You will be instructed on how to check your tip status, and if actionable, how to collect your reward anonymously.

SPEAK UP & STAY SAFE



PSC is a program provided to students that offers an anonymous way to report crime in your school, neighborhood, or on the Internet. You may be afraid to report a problem because of name-calling, retaliation, or police involvement. If you are the victim, or witness of a crime (or hear about a crime), you should report it.

WHY REPORT?

- To protect the safety, welfare, and rights of yourself and others.
- To make the school or police aware of an incident or problem.
- To keep a problem from escalating, prevent a crime, or help solve a crime already committed.
- To get help for someone who displays disturbing or criminal behavior that makes you uncomfortable.

BE EMPOWERED

to be strong and confident, especially in controlling your life and claiming your rights. You have the right to a safe and secure environment in and around your school.

to be socially responsible by reporting behavior that might bring harm to a person and the community. Social responsibility is a duty of every individual.
