Teacher Education / Early Childhood Development and Learning (25 seats)

Environmental Science (20 seats)

Exercise Science – The Science, Power, and Professions of Muscle (15 seats)

Students who attend this session will have the opportunity to see and learn about muscle. The first step is to understand muscle cells and to experience on-going muscle cell research. You will then learn more about creating power and strength by learning how to provide safe and effective exercise testing and training programs for clients, and then finally learning about what happens when you take muscles and body systems to their limits by experiencing the stress test lab.
