



What is Transition?



>>> Transition is the process of changing from one state or condition to another

- Individuals with Disabilities Education Act IDEA
- Students MUST be included



- Student Interviews

- Skills Checklist
- Career Interest Surveys



Measurable Post-Secondary Goals

Based upon age-appropriate transition assessments related to training/education, employment, and when appropriate, independent living skills





Identify Services for Achieving Goals

- Instruction
- Related Services (Community Based)
- Community Experiences
- Development of Employment
- Other Post-School Adult Living Objectives
- Acquisition of Daily Living Skills
- >>> Functional Vocational Evaluation (if appropriate)













DECISION: Course of Study




Alternate Curriculum & Standards

 - Support coordinator






WHY TRANSITION PLANNING WORKS!
