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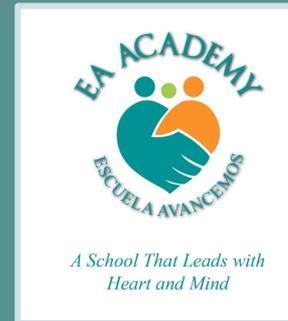

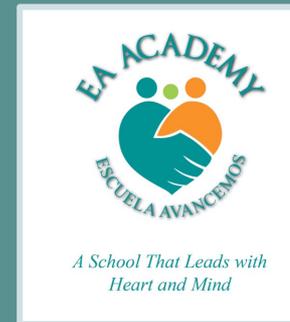

# Root Cause Analysis:

- Identify:
  - Strengths
  - Problem statements (prioritize)
  - Root cause analysis
    - What is problem statement?
    - Why does the problem exist?
    - How do you know it is a school wide problem?
      - 3 data sources
- Examine:
  - Who is in the room
  - What is their lens?

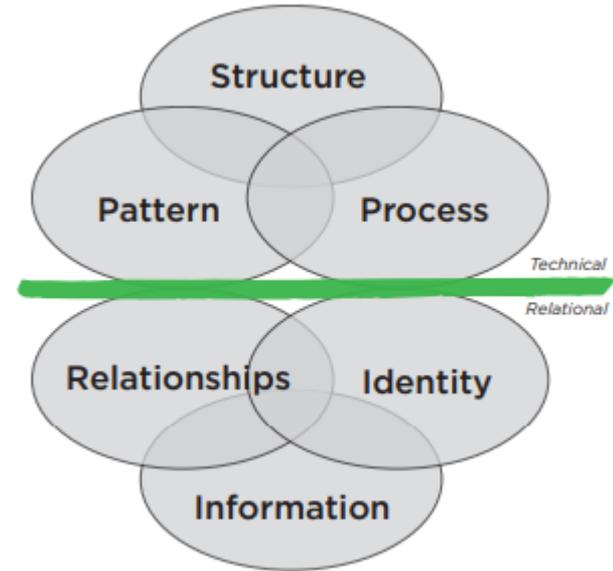
