Service Academy Information

Service Academy Application Deadlines Are Approximate. Check With the Individual Academies for Precise Dates:

- U.S. Military Academy
 - Application deadline: end of February
- U.S. Naval Academy
 - Applications typically open 1 April
 - Applications deadline: end of January
- U.S. Air Force Academy
 - Pre-Candidate Questionnaire deadline: end of December
 - Candidate Kit Documents deadline: end of January
- U.S. Merchant Marine Academy
 - Application deadline: typically 1 February
 - SAT/ACT scores deadline: typically 1 March
- U.S. Coast Guard Academy
 - Application deadline: typically January

It is recommended that students who are interested in applying to a Service Academy begin the application process; take the ACT and SAT; and reach out to their Congressional Representatives in the spring of their Junior year of high school.

A General Timeline for applying to a Service Academy would look like:

- January-June: Begin application process including application form, sat/act exams, and contacting Congressional Representatives during spring of Junior Year.
- June- January: Congressional Nominations will be sent to the Service Academies with a deadline of the end of January.
- December-February: Applications are due, exact dates vary depending on the specific Service Academy.
- January-March: Appointments are received and must be accepted or denied, dates vary based on Service Academy.
