

Assessment Leadership Capstone Course Overview - 2024-2025

School leaders will participate in monthly virtual coaching meetings to become proficient in understanding and communicating MAP Assessment data. Coaching sessions are facilitated by an NWEA consultant who, as an acting principal, has extensive experience supporting teachers in using data to improve teaching and learning. One-on-one sessions with the NWEA coach will prepare leaders to accurately and effectively communicate student growth. As a result of this course, school leaders will develop a data presentation to be shared with the school board.

Meetings will be monthly on the second Monday from 4:00-4:45 p.m. and the second Friday from 1:30-1:45 p.m. There will be 15 minutes after each session for questions and answers. Both sessions will cover the same content, so participants may choose the time best suited to their schedules.
