Learning Walks Overview

Learning Walks provide an opportunity for educators to observe, reflect, and improve instructional practices. The purpose of this learning series is to enhance the delivery of high-quality instruction that positively impacts student achievement and growth. When administered effectively, learning walks can help ensure that classroom practices align with the school's improvement efforts, provide accountability for teachers to maintain high standards of instruction, and promote a culture of transparency and openness.

At the end of the learning series, participants will be able to:

- 1. Define learning walks and explain their purpose.
- 2. Identify the key components and criteria for success of an effective learning walk.
- 3. Plan and conduct a school-level learning walk.
- 4. Analyze learning walk data and use it to improve instruction.

Series Components

The learning series includes <u>six components</u> that will take place during the 2024-25 school year. Both members of the school team should plan to attend all six components.

Expectations

The Center for Charter Schools provides this learning series at *no cost* to our partner schools. However, it is the expectation that schools commit to full participation. - 2. Guarantee the time and resources for full implementation of school-level learning walks.
- 3. Submit the application no later than 5 p.m. on November 27, 2024.
