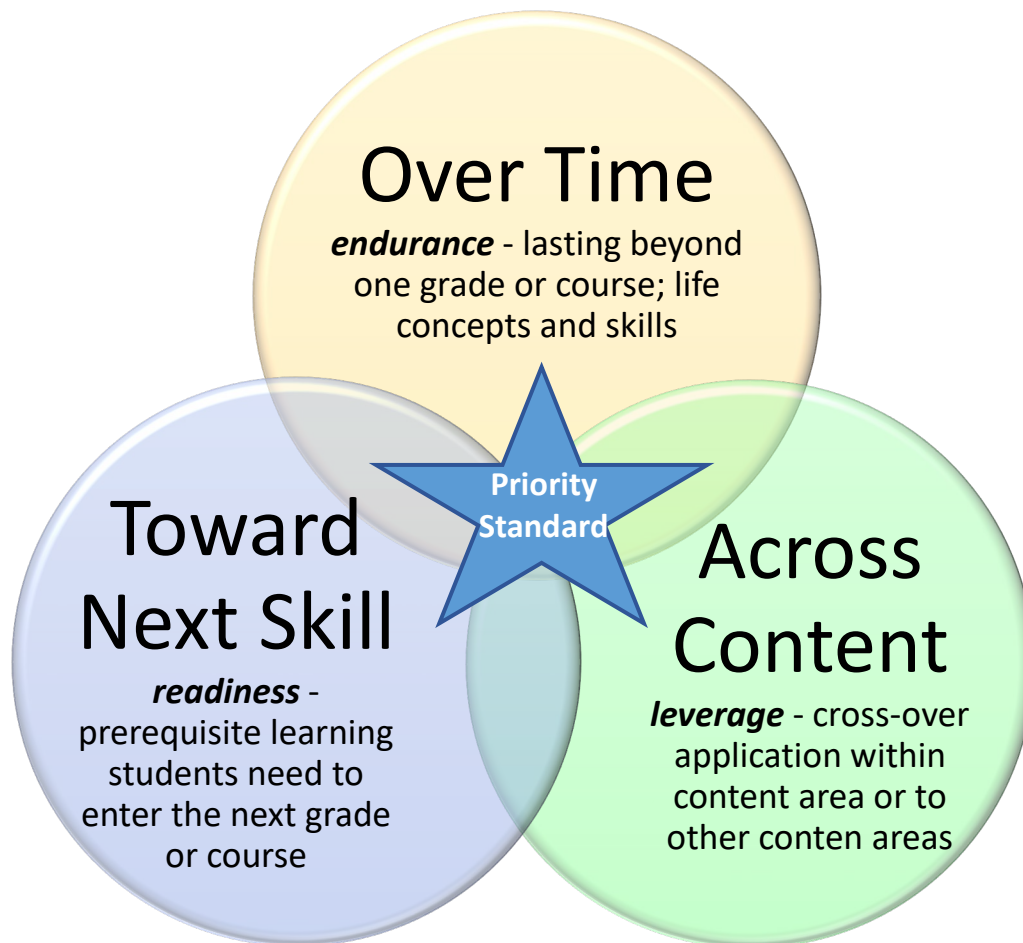


A **priority standard** is one that provides students with knowledge and skills that will endure throughout life, be valuable in multiple disciplines, and provide success in the next level of instruction.
