



Program Expectations

Your success is our priority, and we're excited to be on this journey with you! If you have questions or concerns at any time, please reach out to your school liaison or the CMU program staff.

Attendance and Participation

- Attend all scheduled bi-weekly sessions (during and after school), field trips, camps, and virtual workshops.
 - Missing more than three sessions will disqualify you from the program.
- Arrive on time and stay for the full duration of each session.
- Actively participate in discussions, workshops, and activities.

Communication

- Check the Cvent app and email regularly for program updates, session reminders, and materials.
- Notify your school liaison and program staff in advance if you are unable to attend a session.
- Be respectful and professional in all communication—both in person and online.

Behavior and Conduct

- Represent yourself, your school, and CMU with pride and professionalism.
- Treat peers, mentors, guest speakers, and staff with respect at all times.
- Follow your school's code of conduct and CMU's guidelines during all program-related events.

Personal Responsibility

- Take ownership of your growth and learning—complete assignments and come prepared.
- Ask for help when you need it. We are here to support you!
- Respect deadlines, especially those related to college applications, scholarships, and required paperwork.
